Concerning By-Law #79

Garbage rates had doubled for 2017 with our previous garbage contractor, which lead Council to take the opportunity to buy a truck and trailer. Council achieved this without raising taxes and providing services at a cheaper rate thus saving tax dollars.

If you have not been contacted by the Village Office about this By-Law then this By-Law will not affect your current service.

Council consulted with Local Businesses, Eco 360, Solid Waste and likeminded villages to create By-Law # 79.

It has been proposed to council to change current By-Law to one that would limit every house hold garbage to two bags a week, and allow businesses to do the same. If you exceed proposed limit you would have the option to purchase tickets for additional bags from the Village of Alma as needed. Council does not feel that this proposal would be beneficial to our residents and cater to businesses only.

If you reside in your business you can apply for off season garbage pick-up under current By-Law #79.
