



Residents: Household Waste Collection **Reminder & Updates**

A reminder that residents are to have household waste curbside **no later than 8 AM** on collection day. Recently, a more efficient collection route has been established and your waste may be missed if placed curbside after 8 AM - We appreciate your cooperation with this change.

Residents are urged to try their best to sort in a manner as stipulated by Eco360. Staff reserve the right of collection refusal should the owner neglect to adhere to correct sorting practices. If you have a sorting question, please don't hesitate to call the Village Office at **887-6123**, or visit eco360.ca to access the ***sorting tool***, view your stream schedule, or to set up reminders.

Waste containers: Residents are asked to properly maintain their waste containers. Containers with loose trash, insect, or maggot infestation will be considered a health hazard, and public works are instructed to not empty them until the owners have thoroughly cleaned and sanitized them. If you have an insect or maggot infestation, clean your container with hot soapy water or with one part vinegar to three parts boiling water.

Please note: Household waste will be collected on Tuesday, September 6, and Tuesday, October 11 due to holidays.

The **MOBILE ECO-DEPOT** will be at the Alma Activity Centre Parking Lot, 8 School Street, on **September 7 & 8** from Noon - 8 PM. A maximum of ½ tonne truck and utility trailer load of acceptable materials should be bagged, boxed, or bundled for easy unloading. For no fee, residents may dispose of the following: appliances (limit 1), electronic waste, furniture, small household machinery (emptied of gas/oil), renovation waste, household hazardous waste, tires (limit 8), brush/yard waste, ashes, sorted glass, cardboard, cooking oil, and metals.
